 "December 16, 1848, the Lord gave me a view of the shaking of the powers of the heavens. Dark clouds came up. The atmosphere parted and rolled back; then we could look up through the open space in Orion, whence came the voice of God. The Holy City will come down through that open space." Early Writings pp 33,34
22. Ellen White saw and heard more. She heard the voice of God coming from the Open Space and saw the Holy City, the New Jerusalem ascending to this earth thru the open space. Could it be that we have located the throne of God, the dwelling place of God, the Heaven of Heavens, where the New Jerusalem, the Holy City awaits the saints of God. ### Rescue From Outer Space

1. One day, God gave Job a vision. Suddenly he receives a telescopic view of the stellar heavens. He views immensities

and glories that defy description. Even as he stands - stunned and speechless, God turns to him and says, "Now Job, listen carefully to this question.

2. "Canst thou bind the sweet influence of the Pleiades, or loose the bands of Orion? Canst thou bring
3. forth Mazzaroth in his season? Or canst thou guide Arcturus with his sons? Knowest thou the
4. ordinances of heaven? Canst thou set the dominion thereof in the earth? Job 38:31-33.
5. God reveals the immensity of the Universe through the stars:
  - a. One of these is Arcturus, a sun more than one million times as large as our own sun.
  - b. Presently, Arcturus is rushing thru our densely populated "Milky Way" system, at a tremendous rate of speed. In fact it is the fastest moving first magnitude star in the heavens. Our sun is traveling 12.5 miles per second, but Arcturus is speeding at the rate of 257 miles per second or traveling 925,000 miles per hour and it never loses speed. So great is the speed of Arcturus that it, together with its Sons (planets) is not held as a part of any astronomical system Arcturus is called the "Runaway Star" and is now traveling through our densely populated Milky Way system of 200 billion suns after which it will continue on thru space and enter into another Milky Way System also
6. populated with billions of suns. What a catastrophe it would be if it should collide with another
7. sun! Should Arcturus pass thru Hercules will it collide with one of its sun? The answer is an emphatic NO!! Why not? For, you see, the Bible tells us that God is guiding Arcturus?
8. It was just recently, due to photographs taken by our 200" Palomar telescope using marvelous instruments that can measure the angle of a pin at 100 miles that the tremendous speed of Arcturus was determined. Only recently did we know that it was a "runaway star", a law unto itself, the fastest moving first magnitude star in all the heavens. We, today, had no way of discovering this
9. secret without the use of these marvelous delicate instruments. And so Job had no way in this world 3000 years ago at a time when there was no Palomar Scope to know this amazing fact except the MASTER

ASTRONOMER tell him. Doesn't this strengthen your faith in the veracity and dependability of the Word of God?!

10. Now a second question which God asked Job "Canst thou bind the sweet influences of the Pleiades?" Job 38:31
11. The Lord speaks of the "Sweet Influences" of the Pleiades because they are so beautiful. The Lord speaks of "binding" the Pleiades because it is a group of 250 stars, bound together in the sense that all are traveling together in exactly the same direction at exactly the same speed.
12. Now the following key question "Is it unusual for a group of stars to be bound in this way?" As a matter of fact, this is the only group of stars in all the heavens bound by this kinship. How did the author of the Book of Job, more than 3000 years ago, without the use of the Palomar Scope, understand the astronomical facts so well that he could write this significant, intelligent question? This would have been possible only if the Master Astronomer told him.
13. Now a third question presented in the last half of "Canst thou loose the bands of Orion?" Job 38:31
14. Notice the 3 stars that make up Orion's belt. Notice the sword that hangs from the belt. Now a closer look at the belt and sword of Orion. First the belt band. Remember God asked "Canst thou loose the bands of Orion?" What did the Lord mean by this question?
15. And what is the answer? At the present time, this belt band consists of an almost perfect straight line, a row of three 2nd magnitude stars, equally spaced, stars will approach each other and form a naked eye double but the third star will drift eastward so that the belt band will no longer exist.
16. You see, presently, the belt band is being loosed. Notice, again, the belt and sword of the constellation
17. The middle fuzzy star is not really a simple star, but is in fact a gigantic nebula called "The Nebula of Orion."
